Dear parents! Thank you in advance for supporting your children's choice – to study at Kremenchug National University; I can assure you it will be a real Alma Mater for them.

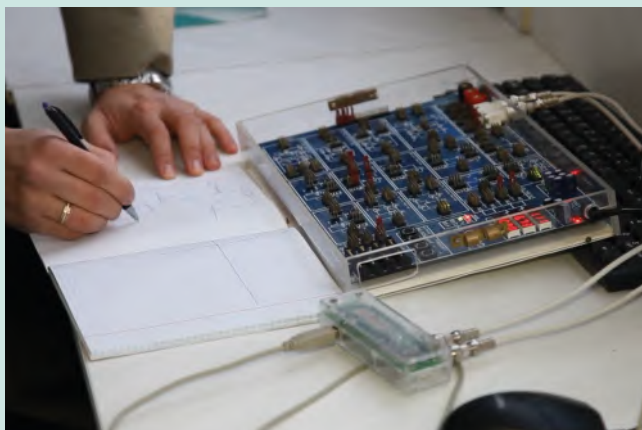

Kremenchuk Mykhailo Ostrohradskyi National University (KrNU) is the only classical university in Poltava region, the leading institution of higher education in the central region of Ukraine, which is confirmed by national and international ratings.

THE STAGES OF KrNU DEVELOPMENT

- 1921** Kremenchuk Higher Pedagogical Courses with teaching in Ukrainian were created. It was the first higher education institution in the city;
- 1930** Kremenchuk Institute of Social Education (KISE) was established on the basis of Higher Pedagogical Courses by the decree of the Council of People's Commissars of Ukraine;
- 1934** KISE was reorganized into Kremenchuk Teachers' Institute ;
- 1939** Kremenchuk Teachers' Institute was reorganized into Kremenchuk Pedagogical Institute by the resolution of Kremenchuk Municipal Council;
- 1960** Kremenchuk General Technical Department (KGTD) of the Poltava Institute of Agricultural Engineering was established in Kremenchuk by a decree of the Council of Ministers of the Ukrainian SSR;
- 1974** KGTD was reorganized into Kremenchuk Branch of Kharkiv State Polytechnic Institute by order of the Ministry of Higher Education and Secondary Special Education of the Ukrainian SSR;
- 1997** The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine adopted the Resolution «On Creation of Kremenchuk State Polytechnic Institute» (KSPI);
- 2000** Kremenchuk State Polytechnic University (KSPU) was established on the basis of the KSPI by a resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine;
- 2007** KSPU was given the name of Mykhailo Ostrohradskyi by the order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine;
- 2010** The university was granted a national status by the decree of the President of Ukraine.





KrNU trains professionals in 30 bachelor specialties, 28 master curricula and 12 Philosophy Doctor (PhD) specialties. About five thousand students acquire education at full-time and correspondence departments. Their education is provided by about 300 lecturers, including, 54 Doctors of Science, Professors and 171 Philosophy Doctors, Associate Professors. Among them there are 13 academicians and seven correspondent members of the branch Academies of Sciences of Ukraine, 16 holders of honorary state titles, seven laureates of the State Award of Ukraine in the field of science and technology, 29 laureates of the President's Award and scholarship holders of the scholarship of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine and the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine for young scientists.





In recent years, by the number of prize-winning places in the II stage of the All-Ukrainian competition of student research work in the natural, engineering and human sciences, KrNU ranks third – the sixth position among all higher education institutions of Ukraine. We are also proud of the results of our students in the II round of the All-Ukrainian Student Olympiad among the HEI of Ukraine, our institution ranks third – the fifth position among the classical universities.





In the recent three years, more than 80 international grant and academic exchange programs, as well as scholarship programs with universities from seven European Union countries, Canada and the USA, including Erasmus + KA1, have been implemented for the first time in the history of KrNU: international credit mobility (30 lecturers and 12 students and Ph.D. student mobility), including the training of ICAM (France) masters at our University during five years. Last year KrNU first joined a consortium implementing the project «Framework for Digital Competencies for Ukrainian Teachers and Other Citizens» under the KA2 Erasmus + direction.

The educational process takes place in two educational-research institutes, four departments and two colleges. The structure of the university consists of 28 sub-departments, 26 of which graduate students, and 27 auxiliary departments and services. The Center for international activity, the

research department, the Center for advanced training and professional adaptation, etc., work successfully. Postgraduate and doctoral studies are provided for the training of highly skilled personnel. There are seven specialized academic councils for the defense of doctor's (in four specialties) and Ph.D. (in eight specialties) theses.

Students have at their disposal 14 academic buildings, 28 modern computer classes with Internet access, a library with a computer room, 60 specialized laboratories, an editorial and publishing department, two canteens, a student cafe, a concert hall, four hostels, a modern sports base: sports complex «Polytechnic» (a stadium with stands for 10 thousand seats, the main and additional football fields, nine sports grounds), an indoor swimming complex, an athletics arena, four gorodki courts, six specialized premises for physical training and sports training with the training equipment, a rock climbing training ground, which is the only one in the region.

Students have the opportunity to realize their creative interests in vocal and dance groups, amateur song club, Club of Merry and Wise Men, student theater-studio, clubs of intellectual games «Brain-ring» and «What? Where? When?» and so on. The annual festival of student amateur art «Students' Spring», the open Championship of the Club of Merry and Wise Men for the Cup of the rector of KrNU, the contest «Queen of the University» are held with great success. Every year on the International Student Day the winner of the contest «Student of the Year» is determined.
